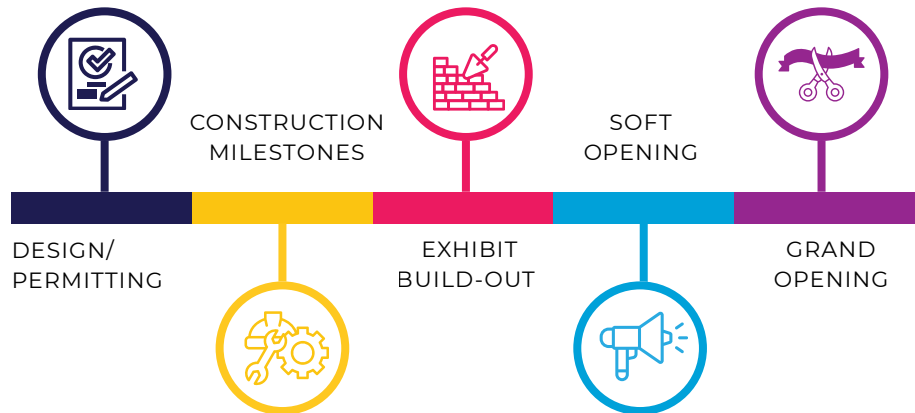

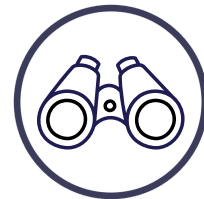
**K WATER ON THE MOVE \$250,000**

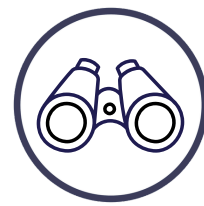

### C MUD! \$40,000

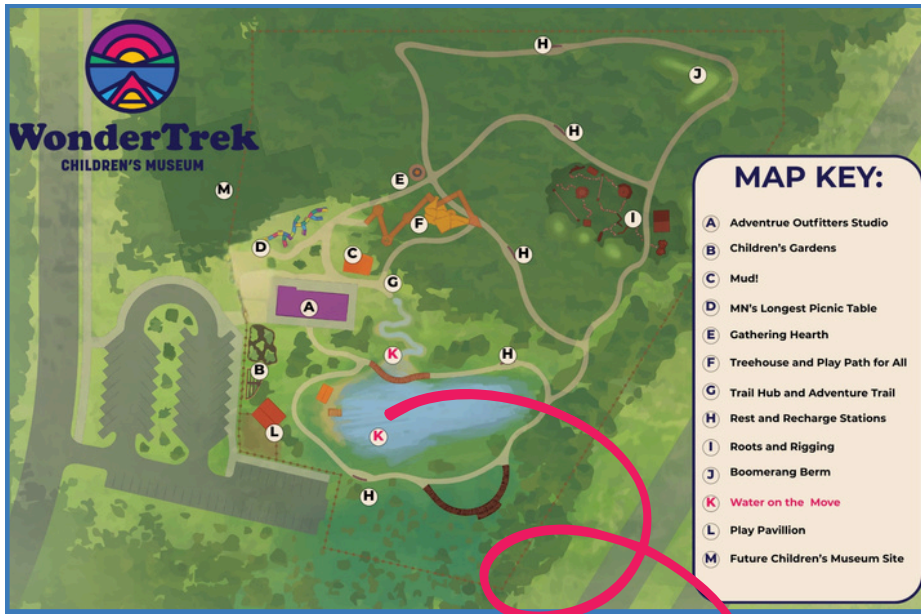
Children are invited to mix, stir, and create with glorious batches of mud using bowls, tools, and water from a nearby pump. Whether crafting muddy “treats,” painting with earth, or experimenting with texture, this playful space encourages creativity, cooperation, and hands-on discovery.



### K WATER ON THE MOVE Stream and Delta - \$95,000

A gently flowing stream winds through sand and rock before spreading into a playful delta where children can splash, build dams, and send small boats drifting downstream. With nearby trails and a dock overlooking the pond, this interactive water landscape invites exploration, imagination, and discovery in nature.





**K WATER ON THE MOVE**  
**Pond and Delta Dock - \$95,000**

A half-acre pond bordered by native shoreline plants creates a vibrant habitat for wildlife and a place for discovery. A gently curving dock extends over the water beside the sandy delta, inviting visitors to explore the pond up close while learning about wetlands and the plants and creatures that call them home.



**K WATER ON THE MOVE**  
**Stormwater Infiltration - \$50,000**

Take a hike on the Outdoor Adventure trail through the Infiltration Basin, encompassing approximately 23,000 square feet, and discover the hidden beauty of an ephemeral pond as you pass shrubs, tall grasses, and blooming forbs. It's a perfect place for exploration, nature immersion, and sparking curiosity about where water comes from—and where it goes.





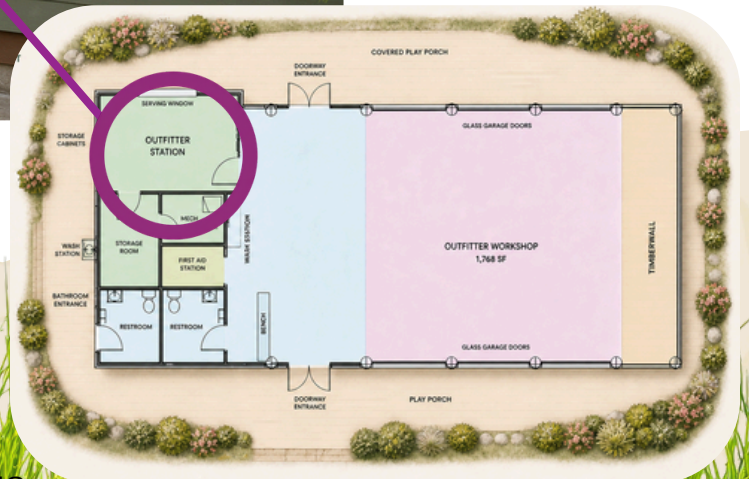

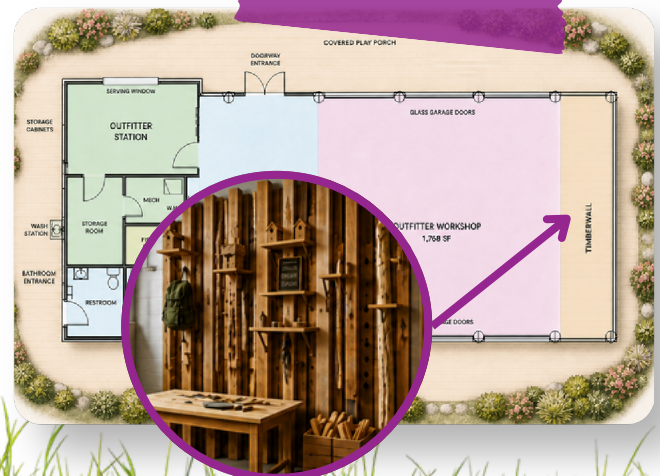
**A ADVENTURE OUTFITTERS STUDIO**  
**Outfitters Play Porch - \$15,000**

Whether visitors are checking out equipment from the Outfitters Station, taking in a storytelling program, or working on a big messy project, the Play Porch is a multi-module hub of activity. Running along the entire north side of the Adventure Outfitters Studio, the Play Porch provides protection from the elements, creates space for programming adjacent to the Courtyard, and helps transition activities from indoors to outdoors.



**A ADVENTURE OUTFITTERS STUDIO**  
**Outfitters Timber Wall - \$10,000**

Located on the side of the Adventure Outfitters Studio, crafted from vertical northwoods timbers, the Timber Wall invites children to build, create, and imagine on a large scale. With spaces for weaving natural materials and collaborative projects, this ever-changing feature encourages creativity, teamwork, and hands-on exploration.





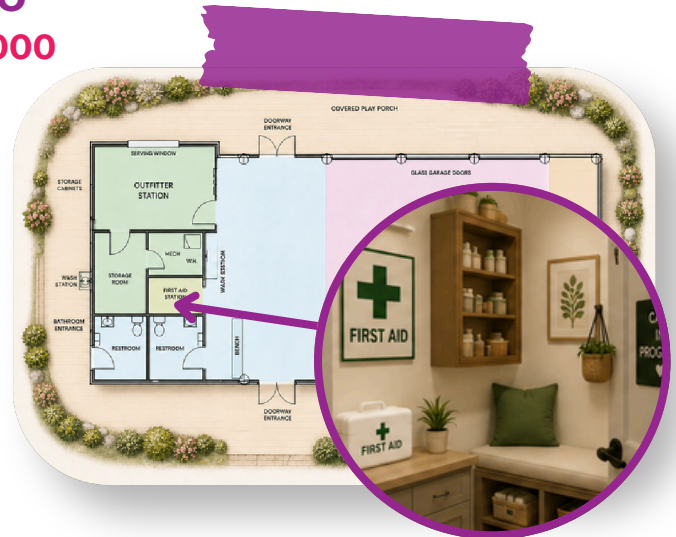
**A ADVENTURE OUTFITTERS STUDIO**  
**Outfitters Family Restrooms - \$10,000**  
 (2 separate opportunities)

Family restrooms will feature child-friendly toilet seats and push-to-flush toilets, multiple hooks to hang clothes and bags, diaper changing stations, and sinks with child-friendly step-up stools. One family restroom will be accessible from the outside and the other from the inside the Adventure Outfitters Studio.



**A ADVENTURE OUTFITTERS STUDIO**  
**Outfitters First Aid Station - \$10,000**

The First Aid Station is a small room just off the Outfitters Workshop, where staff and caretakers can take a child in need of resolving minor injuries or illnesses. It's important that children needing first aid be in a private setting. This room also offers privacy for breastfeeding.



**A ADVENTURE OUTFITTERS STUDIO**  
**Outfitters Outdoor Clean-Up Stations**  
**\$10,000** (2 separate opportunities)

Situated at either end of the Adventure Outfitters Studio, these stations give families a place to wash hands, rinse off, refill water, and regroup after messy outdoor exploration. Thoughtful amenities—including sinks, seating, storage





## **E** GATHERING HEARTH \$25,000

Nestled along the woodland trail, the Gathering Hearth invites children and families to come together around a fire ring surrounded by one-of-a-kind seats crafted by local artists. Whether tending a fire, sharing stories, or simply gathering to play and connect, this welcoming space celebrates warmth, creativity, and community across generations.



## **H** REST AND RECHARGE STATIONS \$10,000 (5 separate opportunities)

Located at five points along the trails, these welcoming stations invite visitors to pause, regroup, and relax. Each location provides seating, shelter from the weather, trail maps, and essential amenities—creating comfortable places for families to rest and for staff to host small programs and activities.





## ROOTS AND RIGGING

- ① **Zip Lines - \$12,000**  
(2 separate Opportunities)

Zipline(s), approximately 30 feet in length, reaching from the heart of Roots and Rigging to a spot close to the main path offers transport and fun for materials versus people, enabling large muscle play. Each of these will have support structure at each end and could have platforms to offer a unique opportunity for another adventure element.



- ① **ROOTS AND RIGGING**  
**Building Starter Stations - \$10,000**  
(2 separate Opportunities)

These stations provide a “starter” point for curiosity, where the provided tools empower children to make choices and take risks in a controlled, natural environment. Partially framed-up four square and A-frame structures offer children an invitation to finish, enlarge, and remodel.



- ① **ROOTS AND RIGGING**  
**Circular Platform with Access Ramp**  
**\$15,000**

This platform, approximately 12 feet in diameter is built safely around a tree, allowing the tree to continue to grow and it is approximately 3 feet above the ground, offering opportunities to build, climb and jump. Young children can access the platform by maneuvering the access ramp.





**I ROOTS AND RIGGING**  
**Balance Beams and Ropes - \$10,000**

Natural suspended log balance beams and rope elements invite children to test their agility, coordination, and confidence as they step, stretch, and steady their way across the course. Designed for active exploration, these playful challenges encourage movement, problem-solving, and perseverance while children build strength and balance through hands-on outdoor play.



**I ROOTS AND RIGGING**  
**Program Pavilion - \$15,000**

The covered pavilion offers a welcoming outdoor gathering space where children and families can rest, learn, and connect with nature. Shaded and open to the surrounding landscape, it serves as a hub for hands-on programs, workshops, and spontaneous discovery—providing a comfortable place for visitors to gather, explore, and experience the joy of outdoor learning together.



**I ROOTS AND RIGGING**  
**Stump Climber Bridge - \$15,000**

This is uniquely designed with universal appeal. Climbing up varied sized stumps is the only way to get up to this bridge, launching countless imaginative play scenarios. This Stump Climber Bridge helps children grow in balance, coordination, and spatial awareness.





## ROOTS AND RIGGING

### I Accessible Cookie Climber Platform \$15,000

Young children practice their climbing skills up stacks of tree cookies to a circular platform that could be wrapped around a tree. A slightly ascending berm provides a accessible route to reach the platform .



### I ROOTS AND RIGGING Hypedome - \$12,000

“Hypedomes”— the 7.5 foot tall and 11.2 foot hexagonal, ultimate cozy cocoon designed for fun and comfort! These rehabilitation stations can be equipped with heat, air conditioning, and stylish furniture. These domes offer the perfect escape for visitors to enjoy playtime during winter's chill or summer's heat. Each spacious “Hypedome” accommodates eight adventurous spirits, making it an ideal place to rest.



### I ROOTS AND RIGGING Rickety Slat Bridge - \$10,000

Step carefully and embrace the thrill! The Rickety Slat Bridge adds a sense of adventure to the Roots and Rigging play area, inviting young explorers to test their balance and coordination as they cross from one side to the other. This wobbly passage sparks imagination, encourages active play, and makes every crossing feel like a small adventure.





**I** **ROOTS AND RIGGING**  
Balance Logs - \$10,000

A series of natural balance logs invites children to climb, step, and test their agility as they move across the course. These playful challenges build coordination, confidence, and imagination while encouraging active outdoor exploration.



**J** **BOOMERANG BERM - \$25,000**

As children roll, climb, stumble, and race across Boomerang Berm, the 12 foot high -100 foot long hill becomes a magical landscape for play. Gentle slopes spark imagination and support sensory development, while the soft grass invites hands-on exploration.



**K** **WATER ON THE MOVE**  
Recreation Dock and Paddle Station  
\$25,000

At a break in the thick fringe of native plants along the pond's northwest shore, a small dock offers safe access to deeper water— perfect for launching small watercraft. Older children can try their hand at maneuvering a child-sized rowboat, kayak, or canoe, supported by WonderTrek program staff who provide safety instruction, participation guidelines, and hands-on assistance.

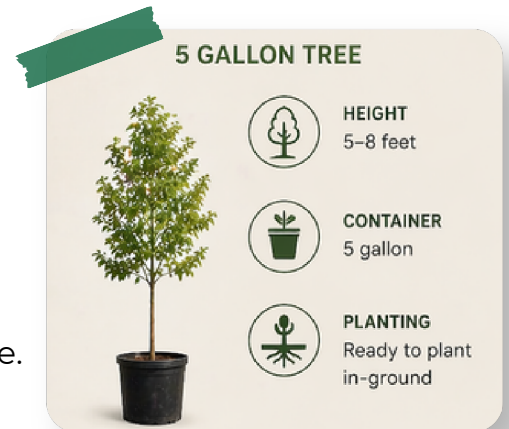

Having a tree planted is an excellent opportunity to enhance the beauty of the WonderTrek campus. Each tree is a 5 gallon container with an 5-8 foot tree. A placard will be placed with your name in front of the tree.



### ADVENTURE OUTFITTERS STUDIO

**Adventure Backpacks - \$250**

(50 separate Opportunities)

An Adventure Backpack is the ultimate way to allow young explorers to carry the magic of play. Each backpack is filled with tools, like a Camp Snap camera (screen-free), magnifying glass, journal, flashlight, compass, gloves, binoculars and other items to spark curiosity and hands-on learning in nature. Each pack helps children explore trails, investigate the forest, and discover the joy of outdoor play.





**A** **ADVENTURE OUTFITTERS STUDIO**  
**Outfitters Work Tables - \$1,500**

A set of custom work tables will be available for drop-in and organized groups. With solid wood tops, these tables (approx. 4 foot x 6 foot) will be well suited for active construction projects and material exploration. Large, lockable wheels will facilitate various program configurations indoors and outside on the Play Porch.



**A** **ADVENTURE OUTFITTERS STUDIO**  
**Outfitters Creativity Cabinets**  
**\$2,000** (8 separate Opportunities)

Featuring lockable wheels and double doors to secure a range of interior fittings, these rollable units, designed in various shapes and sizes, serve a dynamic purpose within the space. Their finished backs are perfect for temporary display, allowing the cabinets to also be used as versatile room dividers. When a wide- open area is needed, these mobile units can be easily moved to the perimeter or even out to the Play Porch.



**K** **WATER ON THE MOVE**  
**Stream Play Tool Rack - \$3,000**

Located beside the creek, the Stream Play Tool Rack holds shovels, buckets, funnels, sifters, and other tools that invite children to experiment with moving water and sand. With everything close at hand, young explorers can dig, pour, build, and discover how water shapes the landscape through hands-on play.





**D** **MINNESOTA'S LONGEST PICNIC TABLE AND COURTYARD**  
**Engraved Bricks - \$100**  
(Many separate Opportunities)
